



## **ALERT:** Possible scam targeting EANGUS members

### **EANGUS Member,**

Information Assurance sources in the military have identified a possible credit card scam that is targeting soldiers in the National Guard. They sent out the following notice through their military e-mail services:

Soldiers are being contacted via telephone from an organization claiming to be from the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS). This organization is requesting donations by credit card for families of deployed soldiers. They are unable to supply a return phone number when asked to verify their identity.

Though EANGUS is a legitimate organization, we would like to remind everyone of the high risk of identity theft when disclosing your credit card information to an unknown party over the telephone.
